#### Gospel

When Judas had gone Jesus said:

'Now has the Son of Man been glorified,

and in him God has been alorified.

If God has been glorified in him,

God will in turn glorify him in himself,

and will glorify him very soon.

'My little children,

I shall not be with you much longer.

You will look for me,

and, as I told the Jews,

where I am going, you cannot come.

I give you a new commandment:

love one another;

just as I have loved you,

you also must love one another.

By this love you have for one another, everyone will know that you are my disciples.'

Did you know?

Points of interest and Catholic lore

- The title 'Son of Man' is one that is often used by Jesus in the gospels to describe
- In the Gospel of John, when Jesus speaks of being glorified or exalted, he is referring to his death on the cross. For John, this is the moment of supreme triumph for Jesus.
- This text comes from a section of John's Gospel known as the Farewell Discourse. which is delivered by Jesus to his friends just before his arrest. Here, Judas has already gone out to betray him.
