Recent Death:

Sister Nathalie Becquart XMCJ,

a French nun of the Congregation of Xavières, was appointed by Pope Francis in 2021 as Undersecretary of the Synod of Bishops. She is the first woman to ever hold a position of this seniority in the Vatican and the first woman to have voting rights in the Synod of Bishops. Sr Nathalie is one of the most influential women in the Vatican.
