Stewardship and Clergy Envelopes

Every year we spend approximately \$3,798 for the provision and printing of the parishes Steward-ship/Clergy envelopes. For cost saving purposes, the parish will now be printing our own envelopes and this will commence from the 9th of July, when the new set of envelopes will be due. The new set of envelopes will start being rolled out for parishioners to pick up from the 24/25th of June onwards. The new envelopes is attached for your information. Obviously the parish would prefer direct debits or credit cards as this will be a further cost saving. Direct debit forms are available in the Foyer should you wish to change your method of donation.

Please bear with us as we transition to this new envelope system. The new envelopes will only have one section and all envelope numbers will be printed on the individual envelopes. Parishioners will

need to fill in the date of giving together with the amounts for Stewardship and Clergy.

Gospel

Mt 9:36 – 10:8

A reading from the holy Gospel according to Matthew

He summoned his twelve disciples, and sent them out.

When Jesus saw the crowds he felt sorry for them because they were harassed and dejected, like sheep without a shepherd. Then he said to his disciples, 'The harvest is rich but the labourers are few, so ask the Lord of the harvest to send labourers to his harvest.'

He summoned his twelve disciples, and gave them authority over unclean spirits with power to cast them out and to cure all kinds of diseases and sickness.

These are the names of the twelve apostles: first, Simon who is called Peter, and his brother Andrew; James the son of Zebedee, and his brother John; Philip and Bartholomew; Thomas, and Matthew the tax collector; James the son of Alphaeus, and Thaddaeus; Simon the Zealot and Judas Iscariot, the one who was to betray him. These twelve Jesus sent out, instructing them as follows:

'Do not turn your steps to pagan territory, and do not enter any Samaritan town; go rather to the lost sheep of the House of Israel. And as you go, proclaim that the kingdom of heaven is close at hand. Cure the sick, raise the dead, cleanse the lepers, cast out devils. You received without charge, give without charge.'
