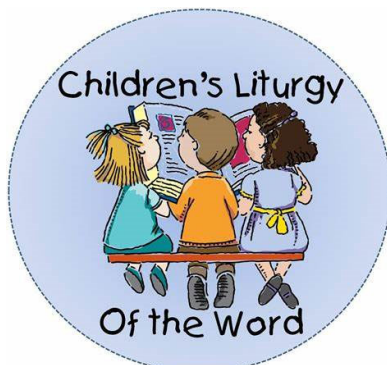

Gospel

Mt 10:37-42
