Join us for a Blessed First Holy Communion Celebration!



Readings

GOSPEL: Matthew 13:24-30

Jesus put a parable before the crowds, 'The kingdom of heaven may be compared to a man who sowed good seed in his field. While everybody was asleep his enemy came, sowed darnel all among the wheat, and made off. When the new wheat sprouted and ripened, the darnel appeared as well. The owner's servants went to him and said, `Sir, was it not good seed that you sowed in your field? If so, where does the darnel come from?' `Some enemy has done this,' he answered. And the servants said, 'Do you want us to go out and weed it out?' But he said, 'No, because when you weed out the darnel you might pull up the wheat with it. Let both grow until the harvest; and at harvest time I shall say to the reapers: First collect the darnel and tie it in bundles to be burnt, then gather the wheat into my barn'

• Identify some of the positive and negative aspects of your character or personality. How do you deal with the less attractive side of yourself?

DID YOU KNOW?

- Darnel is an annual grass commonly found in grain fields as a weed. When it first shoots it looks very much like wheat.
- There are echoes in this gospel of the final judgment when the good will be separated from the bad, the sheep from the goats, the weeds from the harvest.
