### You're Invited to a Virtual Discussion - Synod on Synodality Room for Everyone in Our Church

The next Synod session this October will be crucial as it will set the tone and lay the groundwork for the second Synod in October 2024.

The open consultative, listening style of the Instrumentum Laboris must be established as the normal operating procedure of the Church to enable it to regain credibility and relevance. Particular issues such as the status of women, LGBTQI+, and remarried people must be resolved responsibly.

The focus of the Synod on Synodality – Room for Everyone in Our Church convocation will be a discussion on these issues. Leading the discussion is one of the ACBC's representatives at the Synod, Shane Mackinlay, Bishop of Sandhurst (Vic) who will reflect on his hopes and expectations for the October meeting and the implications for the Church in Australia.



### Year A - 23rd Sunday in Ordinary Time

## Gospel

Matthew 18:15-20

If your brother or sister listens to you, you will have won that person back.

Jesus said to his disciples: 'If your brother does something wrong, go and have it out with him alone, between your two selves. If he listens to you, you have won back your brother. If he does not listen, take one or two others with you: the evidence of two or three witnesses is required to sustain any charge. But if he refuses to listen to these, report it to the community; and if he refuses to listen to the community, treat him like a pagan or a tax collector.

'I tell you solemnly, whatever you bind on earth shall be considered bound in heaven; whatever you loose on earth shall be considered loosed in heaven.

'I tell you solemnly once again, if two of you on earth agree to ask anything at all, it will be granted to you by my Father in heaven. For where two or three meet in my name, I shall be there with them.'

This passage in the Bible is where Jesus instructs his followers on resolving conflicts within the Christian community. It outlines a private approach to address issues, involving witnesses if needed, and eventually seeking resolution within the church. The passage highlights the authority of believers to make decisions in accordance with God's will, and it emphasizes the power of collective prayer and Jesus' presence among those gathered. It underscores the importance of forgiveness, reconciliation, and seeking wise counsel in resolving conflicts, with applications extending beyond religious contexts.
